

# Zermatt Entsorgung – Waste calendar 2024

«THE RIGHT BIN» Join in, and find the right bin!



## Household waste



**Municipal waste must be disposed of via the system involving the purchase of official bags or seals.**

Private households: The **orange bags** available for purchase (17, 35 and 60 litres) can be disposed of **daily** at the public waste collection points.

Catering and commercial businesses and service providers: **Waste containers** standing on private property are to be placed at the roadside by 7.30 a.m. on the day of collection (**Tuesday and Thursday**) and removed again once empty. The **council charges one seal** and one **collection sticker** per container for emptying these containers. Alternatively, municipal waste can also be disposed of in the official orange bags at both public waste collection points.

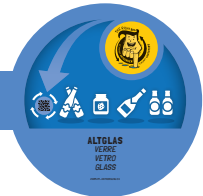
## Paper and cardboard collection



Private households: Waste paper and cardboard can be disposed of **daily** in the skips provided around the village for this purpose.

Catering and commercial businesses and service providers: Waste paper and cardboard can be disposed of daily at the public commercial collection points or from **Monday to Friday** at the waste and recycling collection point in Spiss.

## Glass



Private households: Glass can be disposed of **daily** from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. at the public glass containers.

Catering and commercial businesses and service providers: **Waste containers** standing on private property are to be placed at the roadside by 7.30 a.m. on the day of collection (**Monday, Wednesday and Friday**) and removed again once empty. The council charges one **collection sticker** for emptying each container. Alternatively, glass can also be disposed of at the waste and recycling collection point in Spiss.

## Aluminium and tin



Private households: Cans and tins can be disposed of **daily** at the public collection points in the containers/skips provided.

Catering and commercial businesses and service providers: Cans and tins can be disposed of from **Monday to Friday** at the waste and recycling collection point in Spiss.

## PET bottles

Private households: PET bottles can be disposed of **daily** in the containers provided for this purpose around the village. Catering and commercial businesses and service providers: PET bottles can be disposed of daily at the collection point in Spiss.

## Green waste (May to October)

Private households: Green waste can be disposed of **daily** in the containers provided for this purpose around the village. Large quantities should be taken directly to the collection point in Spiss whenever possible.

Catering and commercial businesses and service providers: Green waste can be disposed of **daily** at the collection point in Spiss.



## Kitchen waste

Private households: Biodegradable waste can be disposed of **daily** in the containers (not in plastic bags) provided for this purpose at defined collection points. Alternatively, and by prior arrangement, the waste can also be disposed of via a catering business.

Catering and commercial businesses and service providers: **Waste containers** standing on private property are to be placed at the roadside by 7.30 a.m. on the day of collection (**left-hand side Vispa; Monday, Wednesday and Friday / right-hand side Vispa: Tuesday and Thursday**) and removed again once empty. The council charges one **collection sticker** for emptying each container.



## Cooking oil

Collections of used cooking oil from catering businesses must be **arranged in advance by e-mail** to [info@zermatt-entsorgung.ch](mailto:info@zermatt-entsorgung.ch), stating the size and number of containers.

## Mobile recycling collection point (new times as of December 1, 2023)

The mobile collection point can be used by private households to dispose of small quantities ( $\leq 50$  kg) of all waste groups that are not collected and accepted at the collection point

## Public holidays

There is no municipal waste collection on public holidays, and the collection point in Spiss and the mobile collection point are closed.

Failure to comply with the municipal waste regulations (AR) may result in a fine of up to CHF 10'000.- (Art. 37 Abs. 1 AR).
